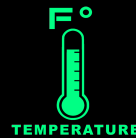


Death Stalker Scorpion

**UNDERGROUND
REPTILES**



- Tank Temperatures: A temperature between 75-85 degrees is ideal for this scorpion.
- Heat Lighting: No external heat sources are needed if these guys are kept at room temperature.
- UVB Lighting: Death Stalkers are nocturnal and therefore uvb lighting is not needed for them.



Humidity levels should typically be around 30-40%.



• Deathstalkers most enjoy their prey alive. They will eat crickets, earthworms, and other small insects. We also recommend you place their prey in their enclosure using a long pair of tongs.



- Enclosure Size: A death stalker will fit nicely in a 5 gallon tank.
- Substrate (bedding): This arachnid needs a 2-4 inch layer of either sand, crushed walnut, or coco fiber.
- Accessories: A small water dish, rocks, cork bark, and hide spot are the perfect cage accessories.



This scorpion should only be kept by advanced and very experienced keepers. They are venomous and are quite dangerous. For these reasons alone, no beginners or intermediate keepers should consider this animal.



This species gives live birth. You can expect the mother to deliver her babies about 122 - 277 days after mating has occurred. The mother can give birth to up to 87 babies.



Although Death Stalkers have multiple sets of eyes, they do not have good vision. Deathstalkers utilize their sense of touch to navigate and hunt.
